

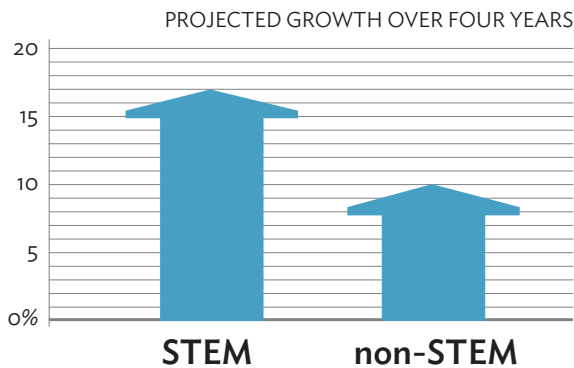

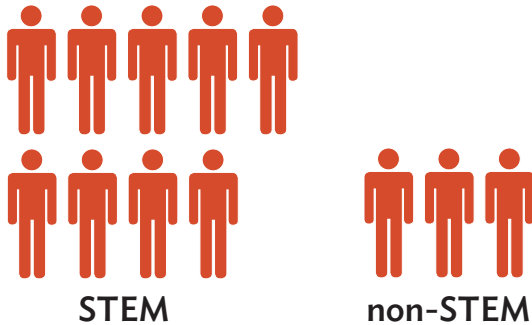

Mix-and-Match STEM Stats

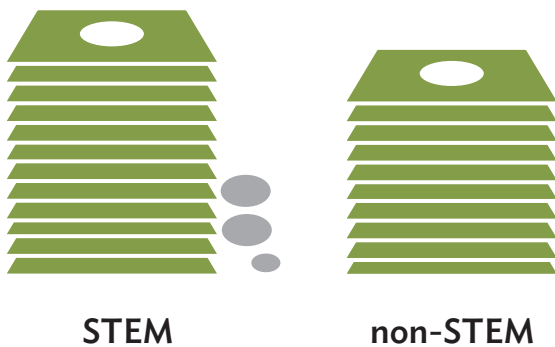
Print copies and cut along the lines to create six individual puzzle pieces for students.



The number of STEM occupations are projected to grow by 17 percent through 2018, compared to 10 percent growth for non-STEM occupations. (2014)



Over the past 10 years, growth in STEM jobs was three times as fast as growth in non-STEM jobs. (2013)



STEM workers earn 26 percent more than people working in other occupations. (2013)
