“I Will Be Your Friend” *CD track 2*

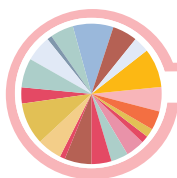
“Vem Kan Segla?” (Swedish: “Who Can Sail?”) *CD track 4*

Rhythm, Rhyme & Respect

Listen to “Something for Me, Something for You” and encourage students to keep the beat by clapping, snapping or tapping. Next, invite them to create an original rap about what friendship, respect and peace look like and feel like in your school. To make a “chain rap,” let students take turns adding a line to the poem. As a class, develop a performance piece using the chain rap. If possible, ask other classes to contribute verses and participate in the presentation.

To extend the activity, create a paper chain using strips of colored paper on which each student writes a line of the rap. Tape or glue the links together and display the “chain rap” in the classroom or hallway.
